Karsten has "published" the status report for the field trials concerning Corrosion Product Sampling and Analysis in the closed FB group

SIAPWS has proposes that IAPWS EC may support experiments/analysis conducted in relation to TGD work, but Barry Dooley thinks that the chances of getting that through are small. Instead he suggests an international collaboration, in which IAPWS could support a young scientist.

Roger suggests that we ask the power plant labs (Karlshamn, Nordjyllandsværket, and perhaps Force Technology in Vejen) if they would pay the fee of SIAPWS by analytical work when needed. This could be a win/win situation for both parts.
