2. Review of the SIAPWS Statutes

- The statutes have been reviewed.
- New section on the Nordic collaboration has been added
- Membership has been changed to only a few to reflect the new organization. The tree countries have each two members and the group members may have one, if they wish.
- Election of members two members from each country, recommended by the national organisations, and the group members can have a seat in the EC
- SIAPWS Suomi has changed name to Vesikemiayhdistys SIAPWS Suomi ry. Monika will change that in the Statutes.
- EC members are elected for a two-year period. Most often uncontested election is expected, but the rules for voting are maintained in case no agreement may be reached.
- Two Appendixes have been added to summaries the SIAPWS Vision and Mission. These may be changed more often than the Statutes but should be changed in relation to an annual meeting.

The EC members agree on proposing the new Statutes at the General Meeting on 18/3.

3. Budget 2020

- Not much has changed for 2020.
- E.ON Värme has changed name to E.ON Energilösningar
- In 2019 the costs for the SIAPWS website was paid by SIAPWS-DK. From 2020 and onwards this will be covered by SIAPWS Nordic.
- Include the 2019 result in the 2020 budget for comparison.
- Suggestion to add the time spend on the SIAPWS EC work as "a cost". Discussion shows that only a
 few EC members register time spent specifically on SIAPWS, so this may only be done on a qualitative
 base.

4. Preparation for the SIAPWS Ordinary General Meeting

- The SIAPWS annual workshop has been re-booked to the 25-26 August. We will also try to re-book the plant visit.
- The SIAPWS annual workshop will be merged with the SIAPWS-DK workshop planned for August.

5. SIAPWS Events

There has been some discussion of the balance between SIAPWS events on the Nordic and national plan (Matarvattensektionen counting as SIAPWS Sweden). All EC members have experienced the workload of being involved in activities on both levels, and much effort has been put into getting the national organisations in Finland and Denmark up and running. As a discussion point Karsten had proposed a guideline for future Nordic activity along these lines:

- Every third year each national organization is main responsible for the SIAPWS general meeting and the associated workshop/symposium
- The two other national organisations support the organization of the annual meeting including the workshop/symposium
- The two other national organisations strive to organize another event on the Nordic level either as a physical or an electronic/web-event, e.g.:
 - Workshop on a technical matter, either physically or electronically
 - Web-based course development of a course
 - Technical documentation of common interest, e.g. analytical methods or "smart" treatment of data
 - Orientation by member companies of their activities, e.g. if you want input for certain operational problems or want to find partners for R&D.

This should not be at the level of obligation, in practice it may be difficult to fulfil every year, e.g. in 2020 with all the Corona disturbance around. The intention coincides with the SIAPWS Vision and Mission. The proposal is to post it as an intention, then try it out for a year or two and then evaluate.
