The program of the general meeting and the associated workshop is almost ready, and the invitations will be circulated shortly. As a teaser, we mention that we have invited Paul McCann from the UK to tell about the work of the British and Irish IAPWS as well as the with film-forming amines at combined cycle plants. This part of the workshop will continue with a general introduction to the **application of film-forming substances for corrosion protection and preservation**. The next session of the workshop will focus on the **chemistry of district heating water** comparing the recommendations of the Nordic countries. Biological growth may also be an issue in district heating networks and some Danish experiences are presented.

In the evening of 18 March, SIAPWS will make arrangement for dinner for those interested – this is a nice opportunity to meet colleagues and enhance your network.

The morning workshop of 19 March will have the **two new plants in Copenhagen** in focus: The municipal waste plant, ARC (Skibakken) and the large wood chips-fired CFB, HOFOR AMV4, that is being commissioned right now. Both have flue gas condensation and treatment of the condensate and those large-scale plants will be described along with the experiences from the commissioning.

We are currently arranging **a plant visit** to one of the new plants in the afternoon of 19 March – participation is voluntary, if you need to travel home instead.
